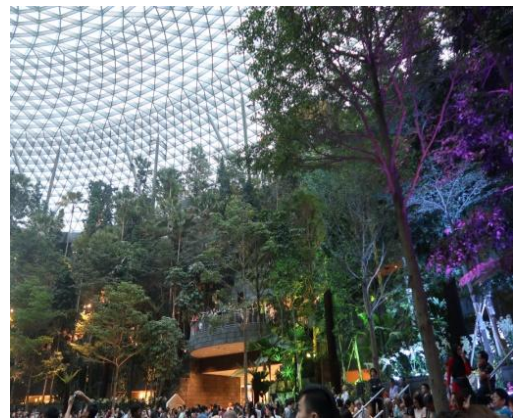


### Editor Writes . . .
